



Work Based Learning Program Participant Expectations

1. Be on site on time and prepared for the work (NOTE: There are restrooms available for you to change in should you prefer to bring your WBL clothes with you rather than wear them throughout the day).
2. Do your best to complete all tasks assigned.
3. Be a great teammate.
4. Motivate each other to keep going, get the job done, and find the meaning in the work you are completing.
5. Maintain open communication with Team Leader, Program Manager, and school.
6. Provide feedback to the Program through requested evaluations, verbal comments, written notes/email, etc.
7. Represent yourself, your school, the program, and the State Park in a positive way to staff, and park visitors at all times. You are seen as a representative of DE State Parks during every one of your WBL days, so please be prepared and positive.
8. Take an active role in your experience – search for the meaningful moments, seek out opportunities for extra experiences, seek out staff in your pathway to network with, communicate your goals regularly to your Field Coordinator and make a plan to achieve them.
