## *General Information*

- ⌘ Set up starts at 6:30, runs until 9:30 am you must be ready to go by the start of the Festival opens to the public at 10:00 am, and runs until 5:00 pm. The Event staff will make the call to shut down early in case of in climate weather.
- ⌘ Check in with Marina event staff to ensure booth location and any instructions that may be needed for the event. Event check in is located under the main tent.
- ⌘ Parking will be remote; you can drive up as close as possible to your booth to unload/load. We will have a shuttle service to run you from the parking area back to the show area.
- ⌘ Tear down can begin after the end of the Festival at 5:00 pm. Please do not start packing before the end of the festival; we will consider withdrawing our invitation for the 2024 event. The Event staff will make the call to shut down early in case of in-climate weather.
- ⌘ Public rest room facilities are located on the outside of the Marina Office, Boat Yard Office and portable toilets are located on the south end of the bait and tackle shop.
- ⌘ Trash receptacles are located behind Hammerhead's Dockside Restaurant and next to the entrance of the Marina.
- ⌘ Please make sure that your area is clean and free of any trash etc. before you leave your space for the day; there will be a \$50.00 fee charged if IRM staff has to clean your space. As Stewards of a Delaware State Parks, we all have an obligation to keep the Marina clean.
- ⌘ The Marina is not responsible for any damages sustained to your equipment or artwork or craft for any weather related incidents.
