Situated on the grounds of Delaware's magnificent Bellevue State Park, the Figure 8 Barn is part of what was once a duPont family estate.

The Figure 8 Barn, with its unique hour glass shape, was built by William duPont, Jr. as an indoor horse training facility to further complement his family's equestrian interests. The estate was purchased by the State of Delaware in 1976.
