Primitive Group Sites are **\$60.00 per site per night** with an additional \$4.00 transaction fee. Full payment is due at the time of reservation.

- 1. Groups can consist of Boy Scouts; Girl Scouts; Church Youth Programs; Non-Profit Youth Organizations; Family Reunions or Large Groups. <u>Any fees paid are non-refundable.</u>
- 2. Tent camping only.
- 3. <u>Strictly Prohibited</u>: Swimming; Alcohol; RV's &/or other camping units.
- 4. Pets are permitted in the campground area. They are <u>not permitted</u> in buildings or pavilion areas. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. You must clean up after your pet.
- 5. Groups check in at the Campground Park Office upon arrival. Guests will need to pick up a parking pass for each vehicle. Please provide a list of names in the group in the event of an emergency.
- 6. Youth/Groups must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- **7.** Visiting hours are from 8 am through Sunset. All visitors are required to pay Park entrance fees. Visitors are not included in the reservation &/or camping fees.
- 8. The Park closes at Sunset. Groups must stay at their camping area from 10pm to Sunrise, unless pre-approved by Park management for a "night hike".
- 9. Trash: Trap Pond State Park is a "Carry In/ Carry Out" park. Litter in the camping areas will not be tolerated.
- **10.** Fires must be confined to the fire rings and cannot be left unattended at any time.
- **11.** Driving nails into trees &/or any damage done to trees will not be tolerated.
- **12.** Groups will be held responsible for any damage done to park property and facilities.

<u>Persimmon Cove Primitive Group Camping Area</u> is a primitive camping area for up to 50 people. A maximum of 2 vehicles allowed with additional parking in the Main Lot. Groups must carry in their own water. There is a spigot located near the ball field. Only Port-a-Johns are available. Entrance to the primitive camping area is through the Main Parking Lot.

Cypress Point A & B is a primitive camping area for up to 75 people. The camping area is located to left of the Restrooms. *Pavilions cannot* be used unless the group has paid a separate reservation fee for them. A water faucet for drinking water is available.

 ** Cypress Point may have two groups renting at the same time, based on the size of the groups **
