The full service Indian River Marina offers many convenient features for boaters and fishermen.

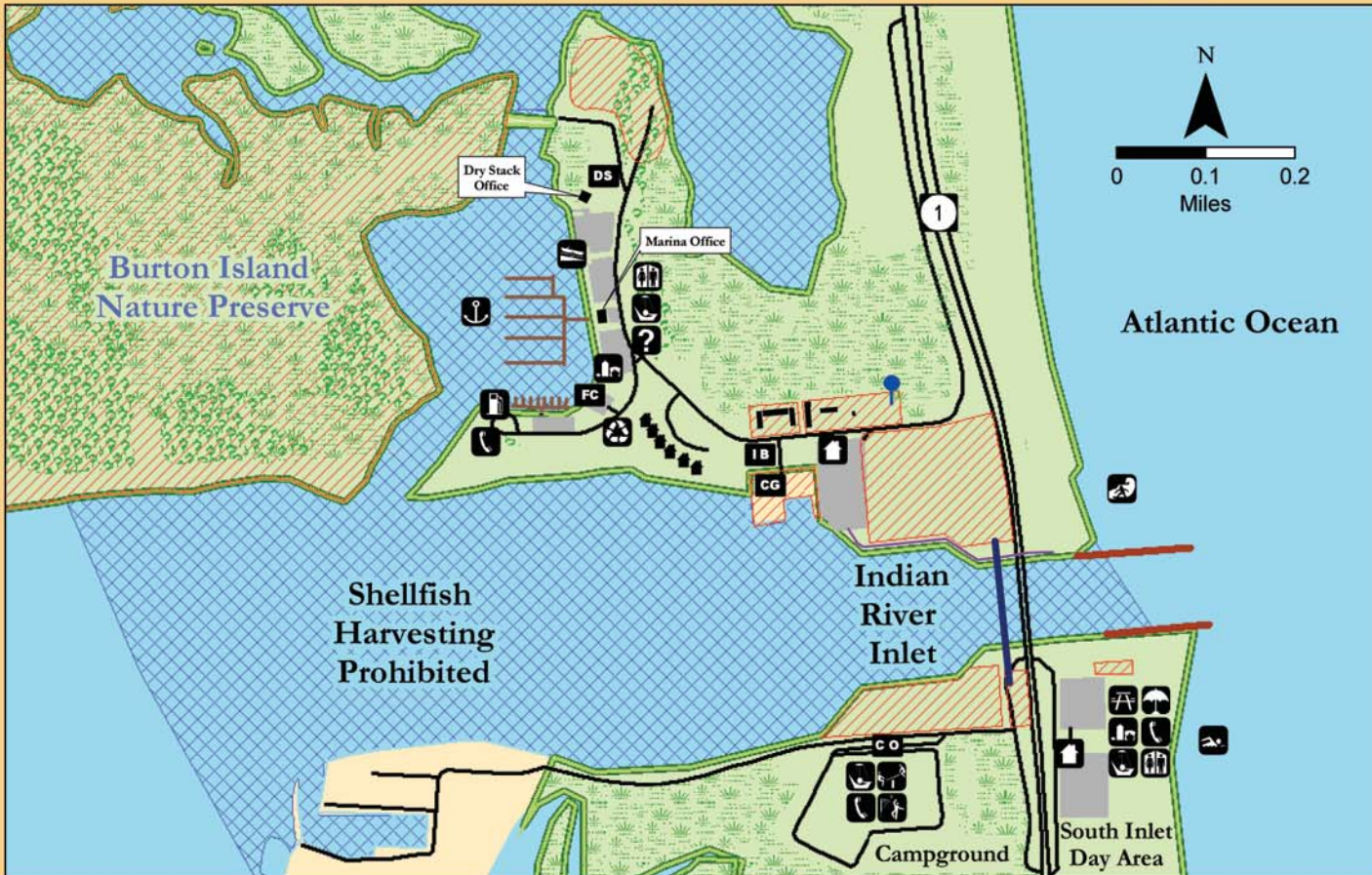
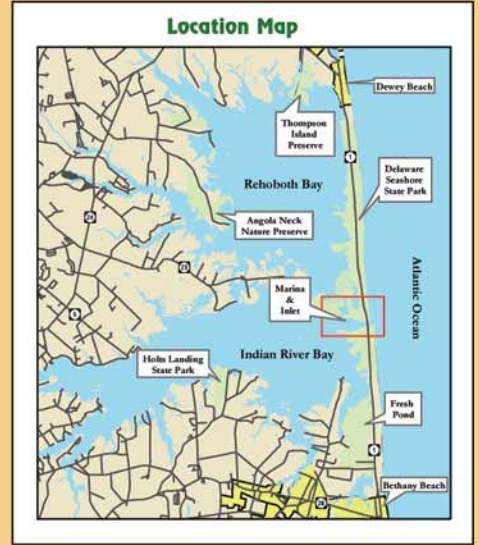
