(Sports bag includes bat, ball, bases, 4 horseshoes, tennis for 2, a basketball and a volleyball)

DEPOSITS ARE REFUNDABLE providing equipment is returned in good condition. If equipment is not returned in good condition, the boathouse management reserves the right to keep part or all of the deposit.

ALCOHOL

- Alcohol is NOT permitted in restrooms, bathhouses, parking lots, roadways, disc golf course, nature trails or rental watercraft.
- Alcohol is permitted, in bottles or cans only, at pavilions/picnic areas and the campground. (KEGS, PARTY BALLS, AND BEER TRUCKS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED!)
- No person or group is permitted to bring more than a reasonable number of alcoholic beverages into the • park.

PETS

All pets must be kept on a 6 ft. leash *except in dog park* and are **NOT permitted** in the pavilion/picnic areas.

DOG PARK AREA

- Located at end of Buck-Jersey Rd. accessed off Howell School Rd. approx. 2 miles east of the park's main entrance •
- To access the off-leash area, proceed past the iron gate and walk down about ¹/₄ mile. Area is NOT fenced •
- There are a limited number of picnic tables available at the dog park.
- There are **bags on site for cleaning up feces**.

CLEAN-UP

Delaware State Parks have a Carry-in/Carry-out trash-free program. We require visitors to take their trash with them when leaving. Small trash bags are available at designated sites to help you help us with this program. Please do not dump hot coals on the ground. There are hot coal pits located throughout the picnic areas.
